Rules for the Auction

Preamble: Due to increased border security and US customs activity it is becoming increasingly difficult to ship seeds by mail from Canada to the US. We have taken various steps to ensure that seeds arrive safely to the buyer. Some seeds are being mailed directly from US growers to the winning bidders, others are being mailed through a central US grower. Seeds that need to be mailed from Canada to the US will need to be declared and duty paid on their value. This will incur additional costs to us; therefore we have made changes to the auctions rules as follows:

1. Bidding & Payment will be in your own country's currency. If you reside in the US, you will be bidding in USD. If you are in Canada, you will be bidding in CDN and for Europe, Euros.

Payments can be made by Cheque. We also accept e-transfers, from within Canada.
2. Proxy bids are allowed. Contact John Vincent at j.vincent@xplornet.ca at **least 12hrs before the auction starts**.
3. Bidding will start at **\$20** & will increase by a minimum of **\$5** increments.
4. Some lots may have multiples and will be announced at the beginning of the lot offering. Winning bidder has first option to purchase both lots. If the option is not exercised, the second lot will pass to the second highest bidder. (Remember no under bidding)
5. Bidders will confirm their winning bids **at the end of the auction** by sending an email to John Vincent at j.vincent@xplornet.ca stating their BP screen name, real name, lot number, winning bid amount, mailing address, and a contact phone number and preferred payment method. Please include lot number in the subject.
6. All payment arrangements must be made during or immediately following the sale. All sales are final.
7. While all the seeds in the auction seem to be sound & solid, we cannot guarantee germination of any seed.
8. Mailing of seeds: All seeds paid by PayPal or e-transfer and will be mailed (unless otherwise stated) as soon as possible after payment is received. We will mail by regular letter mail without tracking. If you would like premium shipping with tracking, please add \$10 to your total. It can take 2 or more weeks for mail to go from Canada to the US, so please be patient.
9. The PECPG ask growers to please keep chatter to a time & level that does not slow the pace of the auction. Thank you.
